10 Points You Need To Consider Before Adopting A Dog

- 1. **The right reason.** Is it a spur of the moment decision? Is it because the children are pestering you for a dog? Or is it because you want the companionship that a dog can bring?
- 2. **Is everyone in agreement?** Everyone who will be involved with the dog must be in agreement with the adoption. If you are adopting the dog mainly for the children, are you prepared to take over when they lose interest, leave home or go to university?
- 3. **Consider your life style.** Do you travel a lot or are you out at work most of the day? Do you have children or other pets that may not interact well with the dog?
- 4. **Your accommodation.** Pets are not welcome in most rented accommodation. Are you considering a move in the near future?
- 5. **Can your family live with a dog.** Is there anyone in your household who might be allergic to the dog? Or is there anyone who is fearful of dogs.
- 6. **Have you the time.** Do you have the time to spend with the dog, to offer companionship, to groom, feed and exercise and train it?
- 7. **Can you afford it?** Do you have the money to pay for food, toys, bowls, collars, leads, and other ongoing expenses? Do you have the money to pay for dog training classes, visits to the vets, annual boosters, insurance payments and possible kennelling fees?
- 8. **Do you have the space?** Labradors are large dogs and will not fit into a small flat or apartment.
- 9. **Problem solving.** Are you prepared to work with the dog to deal with any problems that may arise? Chewed furniture, accidents on the carpet, behavioural problems etc.
- 10. Can you offer lifetime commitment? Are you prepared to make a commitment to the dog for the rest of its life? They do not remain active young dogs forever. Are you prepared to make the commitment for the next 10 to 15 years?
